# LNJ Program Commitment:\*

Lead New Jersey's seminar program takes place on workdays each month during January through June, and August through November. The 2025 Seminar Schedule is available on the LNJ website. Each seminar typically lasts one and a half to two days, a combination of in-person and virtual meetings. LNJ reserves the right to modify seminar dates and locations as needed

Participation in the virtual On Leadership session in January 2025 and at the in-person Leadership Retreat in March 2025 is MANDATORY. To graduate, participants must attend at least 80% of in-person and virtual seminar days during the program year (absent from no more than 4 seminar days). Any participant missing more than this before May 2025 may be asked to withdraw from the program. Candidates should have the support and commitment of their employers to attend most/all of the seminar days throughout the program year.

LNJ is a tuition-based program. Tuition for the 2025 year is \$7,500. A \$1,500 deposit must be received upon acceptance into LNJ's 2025 class to confirm participation. Tuition must be paid in full by December 31st, 2024 unless discussed with and approved by LNJ staff.

Limited tuition assistance is available to eligible nonprofit and government employees. Please let us know if you are interested in applying for tuition assistance—the application will be available upon acceptance to LNJ's 2025 class.
